


Installation of Libby App: iOS and Android




Installing Libby App


1. Go to **App Store** or **Google Play** and search for Libby
2. Install app (if necessary, enter password)
3. Open **Libby App** from new icon  on device
4. The app will walk you through a few questions concerning your library
5. The first is if you have a library card, you should have one; tap **YES**




6. This is likely your first device you have the Libby app on, ignore the first question
7. You can type in your local branch's name or "Saint Louis County Library"; OR
8. You can use your device's GPS sensor to find/guess your local library (suggested)




9. If your local branch or any of SLCL's locations show up tap **"This Is My Library"**; if not tap **"No, Keep Looking"**




10. Select your device reading preference, if plan on reading on your tablet select **"I'll Mostly Read In Libby"**



11. Tap on **"Enter Library Account Details"** to enter your **Library Card Number** and your **PIN**.



12. When successful tap **"Next"** and you are ready to search what the library offers with Libby.



Ways to Search for a Title

Browse

Tap on "Explore"

Search For A Book...



Scroll through the various options (Specific subjects, curated guides, popular books, cross genre guides, etc.) Then tap through the desired categories



Search the catalog


- Tap on "Search For A Book..."

Search For A Book...



- Begin by typing for your specific search request (Author, title, series, etc.) Libby will begin to predict your choice, you can finish


typing or choose the option which fits your search




- Tap on "Search" or the chosen term for results
- Libby will display a list of titles available for the search you can (A) scroll or (B) narrow your search



- You can refine your search to various parameters. Including what items are immediately available to check out



- By tapping "Availability" then "Available Now" you may see the titles and items that are available to check out right now




- Any books that are available will display the "Borrow" option. Those that aren't available





- Set your preferred lending period (7, 14, or 21 days), *each time this is selected this becomes your default lending period.* Tap “Borrow” to finally confirm



- **SUCCESS!** You have now borrowed the title. You may now (A) read the book, (B) keep looking for more books to borrow, (C) choose to read on your Kindle e-reader, or (D) see what books you may already have checked out




NOTE: By default, titles are automatically downloaded for offline use as soon as you borrow them if you are connected to wifi.

Send to Kindle


- Begin by tapping on “Shelf”




- This will show your current loans through Libby. Tap on the cover of the title you wish delivered to your Kindle



- This menu will offer options for you to manage your loan. To send to Kindle (or another device) tap on the “Send To Device” option




- In the next screen select the device to which you wish your loan be sent.



- This will direct you to the amazon.com; tap “Get Library Book”



- Sign in to the Amazon account that is associated with your Kindle
- Choose to which Kindle you wish the loan delivered



- Connect your Kindle to the internet and resync the loan will download shortly. ENJOY READING!
